This Indenture made this 21st day of July in the year of our Lord Eighteenth hundred
 and thirty four. Between John T. Barnes of the first part Davis Barnett trustad of the
 second part and Richard E. Morrell of the third part, all of the County of Winchester
 and State of Virginia Whereas the said John T. Barnes is jointly indebted
 note to the said Richard E. Morrell for the sum of forty five dollar payable on the
 25th day of December next which debt with the legal interest that may accrue on
 the said John T. Barnes is willing and desirous to secure. Now this Indenture
 Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the sum of One dollar of lawful money
 Virginia to the said John T. Barnes in hand paid by the said Davis Barnett
 at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, he the said John T. Barnes hath given granted conveyed sold and
 enfeoffed, released and confirmed and by these presents doth give, grant, convey and
 alien enfeoff release and confirm to the said Davis Barnett his heirs and assigns
 One bay horse. To have and to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be
 granted bay horse hereby conveyed unto the said Davis Barnett his heirs Executors
 and assigns forever And the said John T. Barnes for himself his heirs Executors
 do the hereby Covenant promise and agree to and with the said Davis Barnett his heirs
 Executors and assigns that he will by these presents covenant and forever defend
 right and title of the aforesaid bay horse hereby conveyed against the Claims
 of all and every person or persons whatsoever Upon Special trust nevertheless that the
 said Davis Barnett shall permit the said John T. Barnes to remain in quiet posses-
 sion of the aforesaid property hereby conveyed until default be made in the pay-
 ment of the said sum of forty five dollars either in the whole or in part and then
 upon this first trust that the said Davis Barnett or his heirs Executors
 or assigns shall and well so soon after the happening of such default of payment
 as he or they may think proper the said Richard E. Morrell his Executors
 or assigns shall request after the 25th day of December next till the said day
 to the highest bidder for ready money at public Auction after having given the
 place of such sale at his or their own discretion and given at least ten days
 public notice of the time and place of such sale by advertisement posted up
 at three or more public places in the neighborhood And out of the money
 from such sale shall after satisfying the charges thereof and all other
 his attending the execution of these presents pay to the said Richard E. Morrell
 his heirs Executors administrators or assigns the said sum of forty five dollars
 with the interest which may thereon lawfully have accrued and the
 and of any shall pay to the said John T. Barnes his heirs Executors
 assigns. But if the whole of the said sum of forty five dollars shall be
 fully paid off and discharged to the said Richard E. Morrell his heirs
