This Inventory made this 3rd day of July in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred
 and thirty four Between John T Barnes of the first part alias Barnes trustee
 Second part and Richard E. Morell of the third part all of the County of Southam-
 ton and State of Virginia Whereas the said John T Barnes is jointly and
 Note to the said Richard E. Morell for the sum of forty five dollars payable on
 25th day of December next which debt with the legal interest that may accrue
 the said John T Barnes is willing and desirous to secure. For this I do
 witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the sum of One dollar of lawful money
 Virginia to the said John T Barnes in hand paid by the said Davis Barnes
 at and before the Sealing and Delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, he the said John T Barnes hath given and granted to the said Richard E. Morell
 encroached, released and Confirmed and by these presents doth give, grant, pay and
 allow enforfeite release and Confirm to the said Davis Barnes his heirs and assigns
 One bay horse To have and to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be
 granted bay horse hereby Conveyed unto the said Davis Barnes his heirs Executed
 and assigned forever And the said John T Barnes for himself his heirs Executors
 and Administrators and assigns promise and agree to and with the said Davis Barnes his
 Exe "adm" and assigns that he will by these presents warrant and forwarrant
 right and title of the aforesaid bay horse hereby Conveyed against the claimants
 of all and every person or persons whatsoever Upon Special trust nevertheless that
 the said Davis Barnes shall pass to the said John T Barnes to remain in quiet pos-
 session of the aforesaid property hereby Conveyed until default be made in the
 payment of the said sum of forty five dollars either in the whole or in part and then
 upon this further trust that the said Davis Barnes or his heirs Executors
 and assigns shall and will so soon after the happening of such default of
 as he or they may think proper the said Richard E. Morell his Executors
 and assigns shall request after the 25th day of December next Sell the said horse
 to the highest bidder for ready money at public Auction after having paid the
 sum of such Sale at his or their own discretion and given at least ten days
 public Notice of the time and place of such Sale by advertisements published
 at three or more public places in the neighborhood. And out of the monies
 from such Sale shall after satisfying the charges thereof and all other
 his attending the execution of these presents pay the said Richard E. Morell
 his heirs Executors administrators or assigns the said sum of forty five dollars
 with the interest which may thereon lawfully have accrued and
 and of any shall pay to the said John T Barnes his heirs Execu-
 tors and assigns. But if the whole of the said sum of forty five dollars shall
 fully paid off and discharged to the said Richard E. Morell his heirs
