This Indenture made this 25th day of August in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and thirty four between William Davis of the County of Southampton and parish of Colville of the one part And John Holloman of the same County and parish of the other part. Witnesseth that the said William Davis did on Consideration of the sum of ten dollars good and lawful money of the said William Davis doth acknowledge himself fully and amply satisfied and his much granted bargained Sold at an enforfeid and Confermed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said John Holloman his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of land and premises Situate lying and being in the aforesaid containing by estimation three and one third acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a Briarwood Shrub close to the left side of the road called Proctor's Road in John Holloman's line thence Eastward by said Holloman's line to a pine a corner in James Vughardt's line thence Southward said James Vughardt's line to a small black gum a corner in said James Vughardt's line thence Westward along said James Vughardt's line to a large pine by the side of said Proctor Road thence along the said Proctor Road Northward to the first tree together with all houses and houses edifices buildings yards gardens orchards waters and Water Courses whatsoeuer belonging or in any wise appertaining therunto. To have and to hold the said land and premises to him and his heirs forever. And the said William Davis by himself his heirs & assigns presents Covenant and grant to and with the said John Holloman his assigns that he will by these presents warrant and forever defend all right claim or demand of any person or persons claiming or demanding the said land or parcel thereof. Witnesseth that whereas the said Benjamin Applewhite is partly indebted to the said Jane Applewhite of Thomas Applewhite late in the sum of sixteen hundred and twenty two dollars and ninety two cents by bond due this day and the said Benjamin Applewhite being desirous to save the said Jane Applewhite harm less therefore the said for the consideration above mentioned in addition to the sum of one dollar paid by the said Augustin B. R. to the said Benjamin Applewhite before
