her three children viz Amos Ellen and another unnamed, and Charles Frank, Mary Isaac
the said negro slaves and the future increase of the said Butts his heirs and assigns forever
whereof he is that of the said Benjamin Applewhite should fail to pay the sum of money
above specified and the interest due thereon and the Costs attending the execution and
according this Deed then and in that Case the said Butts Trustees as aforesaid his
heirs or assigns being instructed to do by either party their heirs or assigns or the heirs
or assigns of either of them shall expose to sale at some public place to be designated
by the parties twenty days notice having been given in some newspaper published in
the Town of Petersburg and also at the Court house door of Southampton County for
Cash or on such a Credit as may be agreed on between the parties but if they do agree
therefor Cash the said negroes before mentioned and apply the proceeds in the following
manner to wit first pay the Cost aforesaid and then then the said Bond and in-
terest and if any Surplus should remain then to return the same to the said
Benjamin Applewhite and the said parties further Covenant that they will
suffer the said Benjamin Applewhite to remain in possession of the said slaves
until the sale aforesaid shall take place and the said Benjamin Applewhite
on his part Covenants that he will take good Care of the slaves aforesaid and return
them or the Survivors of them when required. But should the said Benjamin
Applewhite pay the said sum of money then the said parties are to recover
the title hereby conveyed at the Cost of the said Benjamin Applewhite. In Witness

of the one part and James Rochelle of the other part. Witnesseth that for and
in Consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said
Rochelle he the said Spark doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said Ro-
chelle his heirs and assigns two certain lots of Land in the Town of Jerusalem
County of Southampton being the same conveyed to the said Spark by John Butt
and C. Butts Commissioners by Deed bearing date 15th March 1830 and admitted
to Record 17th May 1830. To have and to hold the said lots of Land unto
the said Rochelle his heirs and assigns against the Claims of the said Spark
