 Southampton by his deed on trust bearing date the 2nd day of December One thousand Eight
 assigned a tract of Land Situate lying and being in the County aforesaid for the Commission
 and securing the payment of twelve hundred and Eighteen dollars and twenty Cents and
 interest thereon due to James Scott by Bond from the said Lewis C. Frequent with a
 right or power of redemption on the payment thereof to the said James Scott his heirs
 or assigns And whereas the said Lewis C. Frequent hath paid and satisfied unto the
 said James Scott the aforesaid sum of Twelve hundred and Eighteen dollars and twenty
 Cents and the interest due thereon to the date hereof Now Know ye that the said James
 Scott for the consideration aforesaid have and by these presents do release and
 forever quit claim unto the said Lewis C. Frequent and to his heirs and assigns
 all the right full interest claim demand and from the said James Scott his heirs
 and assigns and to the aforesaid tract of land and do hereby
 acquit and discharge the said Lewis C. Frequent his heirs Executors and assigns
