eight hundred and thirty four by and between Neddy Edwards of the County of Southampton
and State of Virginia of the one part and Willis W Lawrence of the County and State aforesaid
of the other part witness that the said Neddy Edwards for and in consideration of the sum of
thirty dollars to her in hand paid by the said Willis W Lawrence at or before the making
of this Indenture hereunto whereof the said Neddy Edwards do hereby acknowledge
herself to be therewith satisfied, contented and paid hath granted, bargained and sold, that
and confirmed unto him the said Willis W Lawrence his heirs and assigns forever a certain
small tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
bounded as follows. Beginning at a post oak standing near the road a corner of said
land to a willow tree on Josiah Smith's line, thence along the said Smith's line to the right
thence down the road to the first station, containing by estimation six and three fourths
acres more or less, together with the reversion or reversions, remainder and relict
issues and profits thereof. To have and to hold the said premises with the appurtenances
and advantages of every kind whatsoever to the said tract to him the said Willis W
Lawrence his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Neddy Edwards for herself
