to get a new corner for said Mapenburg and Tregant on Murchisons line thence along Mapenburgs
(new line) S 8^o E 18 West one hundred pole to a post another new corner for Mapenburg and Tregant thence
S 8^o West 71 pole to a new line to a small swamp and another new corner for Mapenburg & Tregant
thence along Tregants old line to the beginning with the reversion and reversionary remainder and remain-
der yearly and other rents issues and profits with every part and parcel thereof. To have and hold
the said tract of land, the tenements, hereditaments and all and singular the premises herein before
mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold with every of their rights members and appurtenances
unto him the said Lewis C Tregant his heirs and assigns forever. And they the said James D
Mapenburg and Eliza C his wife for themselves their and each of their heirs the said land with all
and singular the premises and appurtenances unto the said Lewis C Tregant his heirs and shall
well and truly warrant and forever defend against the claim or claims of the said James D Mapen-
burg and Eliza C his wife their or either of their heirs as well as against all and every person what-
