KNOW all men by these presents that I Bailey Bryant of the County of Southampton in
the State of Virginia for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I bear to
my daughter Martha F Beale wife of James W Beale of the County and State aforesaid as
well as for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to me in hand paid by the said
Martha F Beale the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given and granted and by
these presents do give and grant unto the said Martha F Beale and to her heirs and assigns
my girl named Narcissa aged about ten years Upon the following conditions that to wit
the said negro girl is not to be sold or otherwise disposed of by the said James W
Beale or Martha F his wife, but she and her increase is to remain in the possession of the
said Beale and wife during their joint lives and on the death of the wife she shall
serve her husband during his natural life and after her death the said slave shall
and her increase to be divided among the children Martha F lawfully begotten of her
body In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 12th day
October 1834.

KNOW all men by these presents that one John M Bailey and Nathl J Williams are jointly
firmly bound unto Sillister W Stagers Esq Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia and his
just and full heirs of One thousand dollars to be paid unto the said Governor and his heirs and assigns
use of the Commonwealth to the payment whereof will and truly to be made we our heirs and assigns
Executors & administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals
and dated the 20th day of October 1834.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the Court of Southampton County
have appointed the above named John M Bailey Commissioner of the Revenue for the period of
Said Luke in the said County for the term of one year. And if the said John M Bailey
faithfully perform the duties of the said Office during the term then the above obligation shall
void or else to remain in full force and virtue.
