being identified thereto and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture, made the 20th day of October in the year 1834 between John Barham
Owner of Barham & wife Jane, Charles Barham, William Barham and wife Lucinda of the one
part and James E Peters of the other part. Witnesseth, that the said John Barham, Owen G.
Barham & Jane his wife, Charles Barham, William Barham and Lucinda in consideration of
the sum of Forty dollars lawful money of the Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the
said James E Peters at or before the ensuimg & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged, have bargained sold & by these presents do and each of them doth bargain
and sell unto the said James E Peters his heirs and assigns all the right interest title or claim
which they have or may hereafter have in & to a certain tract of land lying, being &
situate in the County of Southampton of which Benjamin Barham deceased formerly owned
it by the lands of said James E Peters, William Peters, the Estate of Matthew Parker, & Sol.
Dolphus H. Parker, together with all and singular the appurtenances unto the same belonging
or appertaining. To have and to hold, possess and enjoy the said land and premises, with
the appurtenances unto the said James E Peters his heirs & assigns to the only proper use and
behalf of him the said James E Peters his heirs & assigns forever. And the said John Barham
Owen G Barham & wife Jane, Charles Barham, William Barham & wife Lucinda for themselves
and their heirs the aforesaid land and premises to the said James E Peters his heirs and assigns
against themselves and their heirs and against all and every person or persons whatsoever
shall and will warrant and by these presents forever defend. In witness whereof the said

and wife Lucinda have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals this day 1 year past
