one thousand eight hundred & thirty four. Between Willis W. Lawrence of the one part and
Nathaniel Regozdale of the other part both of the County of Southampton in the State of
Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Willis W. Lawrence for and in consideration of the
sum of twenty eight dollars and fifty cents to him in hand paid by the said Nathaniel
Regozdale at and before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged, he the said Willis W. Lawrence hath given, granted, bargained and sold,
and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto the said Nathaniel Regozdale his
heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid County
of Southampton and marked and bounded as follows. Beginning at a small sweet gum a
corner of the said Nath^l Regozdale, thence N 35° E 50 poles to a red oak, thence N 24° E 60
poles and 7 links to a maple a corner in Lawrence Gardner, thence N 77° W 29 poles to a
to about gum a corner on the said Willis W. Lawrence, thence S 32° W 25 poles to a pine
thence S 11° W 24 poles 9 links to a gum, thence S 36° E 12 poles, thence S 39° E 6 poles
& 15 links to the beginning, containing nine acres two rods & thirty rods. In the presence
