This Indenture made and ~~under~~ the 17th day of Sept. A Dora the nineteenth hundred and thirty four between Allen Daughting and Nancy his wife of the first part of the County of Nansemond and Jacob J. Williams of Southampton County of the second part. Witnesseth that the said Allen Daughting and Nancy his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars, granted, bargained and sold, and do by these presents grant bargain and sell, alienate and confirm unto the said Jacob Williams his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract and parcel of land, lying in Blackwater river County, and containing One hundred and twenty acres and 3 rods, which is the same land Allen Daughting lot of Anthony M. Clenny and Rhody M. Clenny his mother, and as follows Beginning at a dogwood near the said river, thence down the said river the course thereof 160 p. to a cypress in Richard L. Thomas line, thence N 16th E 1/2 N 3 p. to an oak, thence N 8 1/2 W 15 p. to a hickory, thence S 21st E 27 p. to a hickory thence N 70 1/2 W 25 p. to a holly thence S. 52 E. of p. 5 lks to a water oak, thence N 73 E 6 p. 17 lks to a hickory, on the river, thence down the river the various courses thereof 160 p. to the run of a branch thence up the run of the said branch the various courses thereof 160 p. to the fork of a branch thence up the left fork of the said branch 2 p. to a corner between this tract and James M. Clenny, thence N 29 1/2 W 16 1/2 p. along a line of marked trees between the tract and James M. Clenny, to a small oak thence N 60 E 4 1/2 p. to the Beginning.
