This Indenture made this 15th of September 1834 between James Clark Trustee by a deed of
trust executed by David Royal to John Clark of the first part and Henry Drury of the second part
all of the County of Southampton and State of Va. Witness that I the said James Clark Trustee for
an consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars paid me for the said purchase at public
Sale the receipt whereof I the said James Clark doth acknowledge myself fully satisfied and paid both
parties concerned, sold and confirmed and by these presents doth bargain and convey unto the said
Henry Drury one certain tract or parcel of land being and lying in the County of Southampton, cont-
aining forty acres more or less and bounded as follows, bounded on the East by the Doctor road, on the
S.E. by Granville Shippells land, on the South by James Jenkins land on the West by the same together
with all the houses, outbuildings, waters, water courses, wharves belonging to the same or in any way appur-
tenant, to have and to hold the said land to him and his heirs forever. And I the said James
Clark Trustee doth warrant and forever defend by these presents to trustee any power from claiming

This Indenture made the thirtyeth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and thirty four and between Dixon Gardner of Southampton County Virginia of the
first part Jeptha Parker of the second part and Abram Reddick of North Carolina of the third part -
Witnesseth that whereas the above Dixon Gardner on the thirtyeth day of August one thousand eight
hundred and thirty four stands justly indebted to the said Abram Reddick by bond bearing date
the 1st day of April 1834 the sum of Seventeen dollars & 67/100th of a dollar bearing
date the 30th August 1834, whereas the said Dixon Gardner is willing and desires to indemnify the
said A Reddick from all and every expense whatsoever but more effectually to secure the debt of
said and especially for and in consideration of one dollar & 67/100th in hand paid by the said Jeptha
Parker at and before the executing and delivery of these presents he the said Dixon Gardner for himself
his heirs Executors, administrators, shall grantee bargained, sold, alined and confirmed to the said
Jeptha Parker his heirs assigns forever those houses two feather beds, thirteen bags, household &
kitchen furniture. To have and to hold to him the said Jeptha Parker forever upon the following
