This Indenture made this 20th day of October one thousand eight hundred and thirty four Between Sethos Charles and Mary his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Joshua Deoyal of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Sethos Charles and Mary his wife for and in consideration of the sum of seventy three dollars good and lawful money of Virginia in hand paid by the said Joshua Deoyal the receipt whereof the said Sethos Charles and Mary his wife doth acknowledge with good conscience and sold unto the said Joshua Deoyal a certain tract or parcel of land whereon the said Sethos Charles now liveth, containing thirty five acres bounded by the land of Jesse Sandford, Frances Turner, and Elizabeth Wells dover land and also the land part of Elizabeth Wells dover right, and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto the said Joshua Deoyal to him and his heirs forever the above named parcel of land together with all the improvements thereon. And the said Sethos Charles doth warrant and defend all their rights and title to the above named parcel of land.
