This Indenture made and entered into this 31st day of August eighteen hundred and
thirty four between Valentine Simmonds of the first part and Augustin Pope of the second part
and Thomas Bryant of the third part all of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia.
Witnesseth that whereas the said Augustin Pope hath become bound as security in a number of
instances for the said Valentine Simmonds Esq. in debts to John Bryant by bond for twenty dollars
also a debt due to Lewis Morris by bond for twenty three dollars, in another debt due Robert
Whitfield for three barrels of corn, also a debt due Peter Edwards by order for six dollars, and
debts due to Robert Barnes by order for twelve dollars, also a debt due to John Bryant for ten
dollars, another debt due to James Bryant for Eight dollars due by bond, also a debt due to
Augustin Pope for Six dollars 13^½ cents, due by bond with the growing interest on each of the
debts thereon. Now this Indenture further witnesseth that the said Valentine Simmonds
being willing and desirous to secure the said Augustin Pope in each of the said securities
and also for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Thos.
Bryant he the said Valentine Simmonds hath bargained, sold and by these presents doth grant
Borrow and sell unto the said Thos. Bryant and to his heirs and assigns forever the following
property to wit Two head of cattle, fourteen head of hogs all my household and kitchen furniture
that is not made over before, also all my crop of corn fodder, peas, potatoes, cotton that is not
one gun, to the said Thomas Bryant and to his heirs and assigns forever, and to and for the following
intents, uses and purposes Esq. he the said Thomas Bryant or his representatives may
and shall at any time hereafter being requested by either of the parties to these presents
and sell at public sale for ready cash after giving ten days previous notice, all of the
aforesaid property and pay each of the within mentioned debts interest thereon and
thereon, and the overplus of any sum unto the said Valentine Simmonds or his
widow whereby each of the parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands and affixed
their seals this day and date written witness —
