This Indenture made this 18th day of November in the year one thousand eight hundred
thirty four Between Bennett T. Griffin of the one part, and Seth Charles, of the
part aforesaid. That the said Bennett T. Griffin in consideration of the sum of one
hundred dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the
Seth Charles at or before the delivery and delivery of these presents (the receipt
of which is hereby acknowledged) having agreed and sold and by these presents as hereinunder
unto the said Seth Charles his heirs and assigns a certain tract of land containing
One Hundred and five acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows Beginning
at a post in the swampy corner tree between the said land and George Garrison
and Harrison T. Griffin, thence up the swampy a post Oak a corner tree to the
said land and Samuel Garrison, and George Garrison's straight line along said
line to a pine a corner tree the said land and George Garrison, and James Griffin's
straight line to a white Oak in Thomas Garrison's line a corner tree between their
land and Thomas Garrison; and James Griffin thence a straight line to the beginning
with all the singular houses barns buildings, stables yards gardens
dams and tennents, meadows, pastures feedings, Commons Woods, under woods way into
watercourses fishing privileges, brooks, Cose ments, Commodities, advantages emoluments
and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Bennett T. Griffin belonging with
taming, or with the same used or enjoyed or accepted, Reputed, taken or known as part, funds
members whereof (and the Residues and Reversions, Remainder and Remainder,
Rents & dues, and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof. To have and to
hold the said tract a parcel of land with the tennents, hereditaments and all and singular the
premises herein before mentioned, or intended to be bargained and sold and George Garrison
thereof with copy of their Rights, members, and appurtenances unto the said Seth Charles
his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and benefit of him his wife
Charles his heirs and assigns forever. And the Bennett T. Griffin for himself his
said tract or parcel of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances, before
mentioned unto the said Seth Charles his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claim
of the said Bennett T. Griffin or his heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall have
