This Indenture made this 28th day of October in the year of our Lord 1834 Between
 Harris Executor of Henry Harris dec. of the one part and Mergeliah Broadshaw of the other
 all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesses that the said
 Harris as Executor aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and twenty
 of lawful money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said Mergeliah Broadshaw
 before the undersigned of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted
 bargained and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell unto the said Mergeliah
 Broadshaw his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County
 said containing by Estimation, twenty seven Acres, nine or less and bounded as follows to wit
 at a lightwood post a corner of Lawrence Jowers, and the Morrell land so called thence
 10 1/2 poles to a Maple in Black Creek, thence the various courses of said Creek
 to a pine a corner in Matthew Wells line, thence along said Wells line
 1 1/2 poles to a pine a corner, thence N 88 1/2 W a new line of marked trees to the beginning
 being the tract of land the said Mergeliah Broadshaw & wife lately sold to Henry Harris
 in the year 1830. with all the interest, right, title claims or demand in and to the said land
 land to have and to hold the said 27 Acres of land with the Tenements and Hereditaments
 appertaining thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to the same or any part
 unto the said Mergeliah Broadshaw his heirs and assigns forever and the said Matthew Harris
 as Executor aforesaid for himself his heirs &c. The said land as above described with the grant and
 unto the said Mergeliah Broadshaw his heirs and assigns forever free from the claims or claims
 of him the said Matthew Harris and from all other person or persons claiming under or
 him - I shall well warrant and forever defend by these presents. In Testimony whereof
