

wherein said Toham and to hold to the said Jesse Drury his heirs and assigns forever upon trust that the said Drury shall suffer the said Whitehead to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the above named property until the said Porter shall be liable to pay the execution of the said Drury trustee as aforesaid to take possession of the aforesaid property and of the same at least twenty days next to the first day for cash the whole or so much thereof as shall be sufficient to pay all costs attending the executing this trust, and the amount of the debt interest and costs aforesaid and the balance if any pay to the said Whitehead or heirs. This Indenture made and entered into this the 22nd day of October in the year of our Lord 1820 between James Freycant and Mary B his wife of the County of Fayette in the State of Virginia of the one part, and Henry B Laughman of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia of the other part, witnesseth That the said James Freycant and Mary B his wife in consideration of the sum of five thousand five hundred dollars of lawful money of the United States to him in hand paid by the said Henry B Laughman at or before the making and delivery of this present receipt, whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold unto the said Henry B Laughman his heirs and assigns certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and containing by estimate four thousand and thirty three and one fourth acres in the same more or less, and comprising all the lands which the said James Freycant purchased of the following persons, that is to say, of William Edwards by and bearing date the 26th day of March 1816 of Lewis Perkins and wife by and bearing date the 1st day of May 1816 of James Wells and wife by and bearing date the 8th day of March 1817 of Martha R Dyer by and bearing date the 21st day of April 1817 of Martha Edwards by and bearing date the 29th day of May 1817 of Martha Edwards next grand to Mother R Edwards by and bearing date the 29th day of May 1817 of James Wells administratrix with the seal annexed of William Edwards by and bearing date the 27th day of June 1817 of Benjamin C Hunt and wife by and bearing date the 1st day of February 1817 of Thomas D Ridley and wife by and bearing date the 7th day of December 1818 and of John B Row and wife by and bearing date the 20th day of August 1820. Referring him to the several acts aforesaid which are filed in the Clerk's office of the County of Southampton the boundaries of the said tract of land will be fully explained.
