This Indenture made this 17th day of November 1834 Between Nathaniel Pope and Nancy his wife
 of the one part and Richard Barrett of the other part and all of the County of Southampton and State
 of Virginia doth witness that the said Nathaniel Pope & Nancy his wife for and in consideration of
 the sum of Eighty eight dollars in hand paid by the said Richard Barrett the Receipt whereof the said
 Nathaniel Pope and Nancy his wife doth acknowledge granted bargain and sold and by these presents doth grant
 bargain sell and confirm unto the said Richard Barrett his heirs and assigns forever one certain
 tract or parcel of Land containing sixteen Acres more or less and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning
 at a small factory a corner in the line of the estate of Griffith Smith and thence 38.30 poles to a large
 oak lighted stump a corner of Nathaniel Pope and Mills Moseley thence 165.65 poles to a short
 beam a new corner made near the stump in Mills Moseley line thence 105.06 poles to two Pines in
 the old field a new corner made in Griffith Smith's Estate line thence straight line 30 poles to the
 first station To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and every part and parcel thereof
 together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining unto
 him the said Richard Barrett his heirs and assigns forever against the said Nathaniel Pope his heirs
 his heirs and assigns and against all and every person and persons his heirs and assigns
 the right of the said land to the said Richard Barrett, and Nathaniel Pope and Nancy his wife
 for the consideration of the sum of Two hundred & Seventy five dollars to them in hand paid by
 Richard Barrett the Receipt whereof they the said Nathaniel Pope and Nancy his wife doth ac-
 knowledge & discharge the said Richard Barrett from further payment. In this behalf have
 granted bargain & sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said
 Richard Barrett to him and his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of land situated lying
 and being in the parish of Netoway and County of Southampton containing seventy five acres
 in the same more or less it being the same tract which the said Nathaniel Pope purchased
 from Amy Boyd five women and bounded as follows bounded by the lines of Thomas Bluff
 Griffith Smith, Mills Moseley, James Edwards, and the Granville Run branch which is the line
 of Amos Stephenson To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all and singular
 the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said Richard Barrett his heirs and assigns fore-
 ever and the said Nathaniel Pope for himself his heirs and assigns forever doth hereby warrant and
 forever defend the above named premises in both tracts or parcels of land herein before named
 against the claim of all persons whatever In Testimony whereof the said Nathaniel Pope
 and Nancy his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and date
