 of Alabama of the first part and Robert Messers of the County of Southampten State of
 of the second part. Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of
 of one hundred and thirty five dollars in hand paid by the party of the second part at
 before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 the parties of the first part have given granted conveyed and sold and by these presents
 grant bargain and sell unto the said party of the second part the one half or undivided
 of a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampten State of
 Georgia and containing in the whole Four hundred and sixty four Acres 3 R. 19 A. 8 P.
 the land inherited by the said Jane from her Grandfather Thomas Mason and bounded as

 or claims of themselves their heirs and assigns and against the claims or claims of
