fourteen acres, be the same more or less & known by the name of Camps tract it being the same land  
bought by the said Ann James of John James as well as appear by deed recorded in the Clerk's office  
of Southampton & bearing date the 20<sup>th</sup> day of July 1832 the right title and interest, claims and  
demand of all and every kind whatever which she the said Ann James hath in and to the said  
premises for the above consideration she doth hereby convey to the said John James & the said Ann  
James for herself her heirs Executors &c doth hereby warrant and defend the above granted premises  
to the said John James his heirs against the claims of her the said Ann James or all and every persons  
or persons claiming by or through her In Witness whereof She hath hereunto set her hand  
at West this day and date first above written
