

Harris & wife This Indenture made this 9th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty three. Between Howell Harris and Polley his wife of the County of Southampton

 of the County of Virginia of the first part & Russell C. Musfee of the County of Gloucester of the other part (Witnesseth) That for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars of lawful money of Virginia to them lawfully paid by the said Russell C. Musfee of the County of Gloucester who of is hereby acknowledged have bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed & confirmed unto the said Russell C. Musfee & by these presents do bargain, sell, convey & confirm unto the said Russell C. Musfee, his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of Land with all the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said Howell Harris and Polley his wife situate in the County of Southampton aforesaid and on the South side of the River of Southampton containing by estimation one hundred and fifteen Acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows by the land of Nathaniel Spencer, Jas^s Stephenson & the S^r Russell Musfee in the Land belonging to the Estates of Edmund Warner dec^d. To have and to hold the said bargained tract or parcel of Land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any case appertaining unto the said Russell Harris and Polley his wife their heirs and assigns forever of the said Russell Harris his heirs and assigns forever and we the said Russell Harris and Polley his wife do for ourselves our heirs executors administrators and assigns warrant and forever defend the said tract or parcel of Land against the right title claim or interest of all and every other person or persons whatsoever.
