Know all men by these presents that we Benjamin Verany Esq. Briggs Lewis Morris, James
 Prosser, Edwards Beattie, Clements Rochelle & Thomas Ridley are his wife and family bound with their
 10 Saywell Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum of thirty
 dollars to be paid to the said Governor and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth the first day
 thereof well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves and each of us, our and each of our heirs
 administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and
 15th day of December 1834.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above said Benjamin Verany is
 constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a Commission from the
 Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the 25th day of November 1834 for the term
 of one year next after the first quarterly Court to be holden for the County aforesaid for the year
 1835 if therefore the said Benjamin Verany shall well and truly collect and receive all officers
 fees and dues put into his hands for collection and duly account for and pay the same to the
 officers to whom such fees are due respectively at such times as are prescribed and limited by
 law and shall well and truly execute and due returns make of all process and process to be
 directed and pay and satisfy all sums of money and to be due by him according to the
 such process to the person or persons to whom the same are due this or their Executors, admi-
 nistrators or assigns and in all other things truly and faithfully execute and perform the
 said office of Sheriff during the term of his continuance therein then the above obligation
 to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue
