

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas the above said Benjamin is constituted
and is a Justice of the Peace of the County of Breckinridge by a Commission from the Governor under the seal
of the Commonwealth dated the 20th day of November 1804 for the term of one year from and after the said
said quarterly Court held hereinafter for the County in the year 1805. If therefore the said Benjamin
shall well and truly collect all taxes and rates, and account for and pay the same in such manner
as by law directed, and also all fines, forfeitures, and arrearsments, accruing or becoming due to the
Commonwealth in the said County and shall duly account for and pay the same to the Treasurer of
the Commonwealth for the time being for the use of the Commonwealth in the in like manner as is or
shall be directed in case of publick Taxes, and shall in all other things truly and faithfully execute
the said Office of Sheriff during his continuance then in then the above obligation shall well and
remain in full force and virtue

The Conclusions of the above obligation is such that whereas the above named Benjamin Seamy is constituted and appointed Sheriff of this County of Southampton by a Commission from the Governor under the Seal of the Commonwealth dated the 25th day of January 1834 for the term of one year from the first quarterly Court held within for the County aforesaid in the year 1834 if therefore this said Benjamin Seamy shall truly and faithfully collect, account for and pay the taxes imposed by law upon all assessments of taxes due in this said County of Southampton, and shall truly and faithfully collect, account for and pay the Statute fines due in the said County of Southampton aforesaid and all assessments of Statute fines due in the said County and shall in all things truly and faithfully execute the said office of Sheriff during his continuance therein then the above obligation to him or else to remain in full force and virtue.
