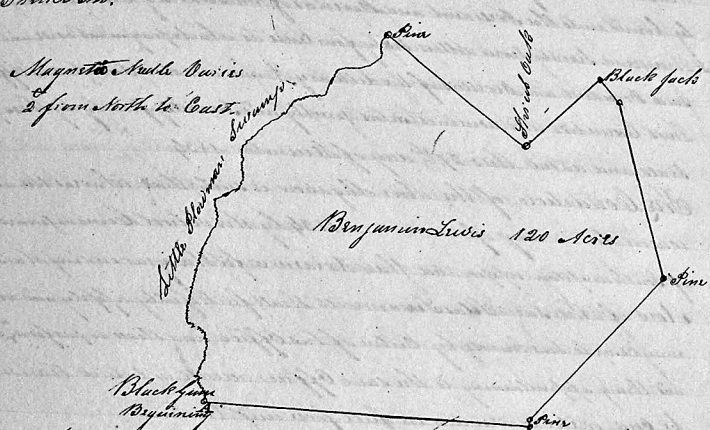

Surveyed for Benjamin Lewis the above tract of land lying in Southampton County
 on the south side of the little Blackman Swamp containing 120 Acres situated and
 bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a Black Gum on the little Blackman
 Swamp at A a corner to David Spruce thence along his line S 72° W 135 poles to a
 corner to the said Benjamin Lewis thence a New chestnut line beginning at Benjamin
 Lewis S 5° E 8 poles to a pine S 45° E 77 poles to a pine a corner in James Myers line
 along his line N 78° 1/2 E 72 poles to a pine S 11° E 11 poles to a black jack N 40° W 40 poles to
 a black Oak N 40° E 69 poles to a pine on the little Blackman Swamp and up said Swamp
 it thence to the Beginning -
