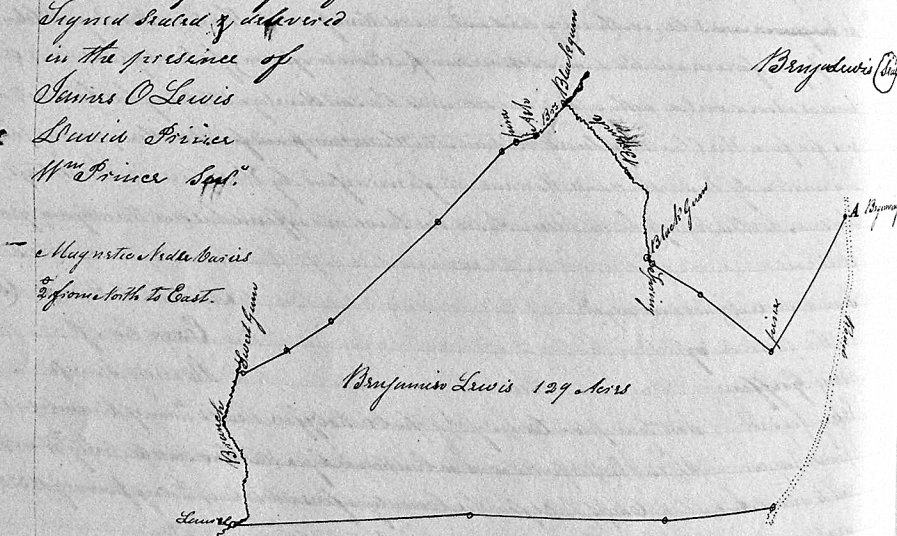

This Indenture made and entered into this 15<sup>th</sup> day of December in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty four Between Benjamin Lewis of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia of the one part, and Samuel Rollings of the said State of the other part; Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Lewis for and to the heirs and assigns of this sum of Three hundred and eighty seven dollars to him in hand paid by Henry Rollings the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and by these presents doth grant, bargain sell unto the said Samuel Rollings his heirs and assigns and forever, a certain piece or parcel of land situate and being in the said County of Southampton containing by actual survey one hundred and twenty nine acres, and bounded as depicted in the annexed plan of the same it being all the said Lewis's land lying north of the road leading to Greenmount the Adams tract together with all and singular the appurtenances unto the said land and Rollings his heirs and assigns To have and to hold the said land with the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Samuel Rollings his heirs and assigns forever and the said Benjamin Lewis for himself and his heirs, hereby Covenant that he will warrant the title of the said land, against himself his heirs and assigns, and administrators and against all and every person and persons who shall or may claim the said Samuel Rollings his heirs and assigns forever by these presents. In Witness whereof the said Benjamin Lewis hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his Seal the day and year first above written -

Surveyed for Benjamin Lewis the above tract of land lying in Southampton County on the north of the Road containing 129 acres Situate and Bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning on the Road at a corner David Prince and said Benjamin Lewis Thence along said Road adjoining said Benjamin Lewis and said William Prince corner along his line 159 1/2 poles N 29 1/2 W to pole N 55 1/2 W 1 pole to a corner on a Branch as it runs north to a Black gum a corner to the side of James Goyard dec. along said line N 55 1/2 W 2 poles to 74 1/2 poles S 77 1/2 E 34 poles to a corner on a Branch as it runs north to a Black gum at the junction of another Branch up said Branch at a corner on a Branch as it runs north to a Black gum at a Spring a corner on David Prince's line along his line S 74 1/2 W 36 poles to a corner S 54 poles to the Beginning
