Simmons which I bear to Zebulon Simmons of the aforesaid County of the other part as well as for
further consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid by the said Zebulon Simmons
before the signing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Zebulon Sim-
mons his Executors administrators and assigns a certain Tract or parcel of Land lying and
being in the aforesaid County containing four and a half acres be the same more or less
and bounded as follows Beginning on the Smithfield Road thence N. 60° E. 30 poles to
Slater in William Simmons line thence along said Simmons line S 80° 10' E. 100 poles to
oak thence S 58° E. 14 poles to a pine in Mason Simmons line thence S 51° W 30 poles
along said line to the aforesaid Road thence N. 15° E. 25 poles along said Road
to the beginning To have and to hold the said Tract or parcel of Land unto the said
Zebulon Simmons his Executors administrators and assigns against the claim of those that
Sam Brown his Executors and administrators against the claim or claims of all and every
person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend Ham by these pre-
