

This Indenture made the 7th day of May 1834 Between Charles Simmons of the first part Thomas -
 Simmons of the second part and Alice B. Nicholas of the third part Whereas the said Charles Simmons is justly
 due by note bearing date with the three percents and the said Charles Simmons being willing and desirous to
 have the payment of the aforesaid sum of \$549.10 And the said Alice B. Nicholas that the said Charles
 Simmons for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid as also the further consideration of one dollar
 to him in hand paid by the said Charles Simmons which he has received and does and by these presents doth he
 give and sell unto the said Charles Simmons one negro woman and child free and also a certain parcel
 of land known as follows beginning at the Reddy Branch a corner between the said Charles Simmons and
 the said Thomas Simmons along the Reddyburg road to Charles Simmons where the said Charles Simmons and
 the said Thomas Simmons have bounded them in North by the
 said Thomas Simmons his heirs and assigns forever upon Forest Hill which is to him the said Charles
 Simmons and satisfy the debt aforesaid due to the said Alice B. Nicholas with the interest that may have
 accrued thereon or before the first day of January next then the aforesaid Negroes and land shall be
 released but in default of payment there being made it shall be the duty of the said Charles Simmons
 to advertise the time and place of sale and to proceed to sell to the best bidder the said Negroes
 woman and child and also the land for cash and out of the proceeds of such sale pay the debt of \$549.
 and pay to the said Charles Simmons his heirs and assigns for the interest which of the parties have
 servants to their hands and affixes their seals the day and year above written -

This Indenture made this 22nd day of January in the year One thousand eight hundred and thirty
 four between Jeremiah Melleford Executor of the last Will and Testament of Jordan Jopson deceased of the
 first part and James Dick of the second part witnesseth that the said Jeremiah Melleford
 before Executor as aforesaid pursuant to the Will of said Jordan Jopson deceased which is of record
 in the Clerk's Office of the County of Southampton for and in consideration of the sum of six
 hundred and two dollars to him in hand paid or to be paid by the said James Dick at
 or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 hath granted bargained sold released and conveyed unto the said James Dick his heirs
 and assigns forever a certain tract of land in the County of Southampton containing by estimate
 four hundred and twenty Acres more or less and known and described in the Will of said Jordan
 as the home tract and bounded by the lines of Thomas Brothers Daniel Davis John Davis the land
 a short time since a long line to the estate of Johnson Apper and a line of Martha Davis and a part
 constituting a dividing line between the said home tract and a plantation whereon Henry Jopson
 and which was bequeathed him by the Will of his father Jordan Jopson the aforesaid
 and assigns against the claims of him the said Jeremiah Melleford Executor of Jordan Jopson
