to this for and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred and fifty dollars to them
hands paid by the said John H Mason before the execution and delivery of this present
the receipt whereof Beatty acknowledged the said Stede and Wife to give, hold and
convey, and by these presents doth bargain, sell and recover unto the said John H Mason
that certain tract or parcel of land situate in the County of Southampton containing
one hundred and seventy seven acres more or less, it being the same parcel of land held
by the said Mason and Wife by their due and lawful descent the 16th day of November 1831 and from
in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County Court, conveyed to the said Sterling Stede
metes and bounds whereof will more fully appear by reference to the said Deed held
and to hold the said parcel of land with the appurtenances, to him the said John H
Mason his heirs and assigns forever and the said Stede and Wife Covenant with the
said Mason that he shall have quiet possession and a good title to the said land from
