Mason, before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Sledge and wife, bargain, sell and convey, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto the said John J. Mason that certain tract or parcel of land situate in the County of Southhampton containing one hundred and seventy seven Acres more or less, it being the same parcel of land which the said Mason and wife by their deed dated the 16th day of November 1831 and of record in the Clerks Office of Southhampton County Court, conveyed to the said Sterling Sledge and wife, and to hold the said parcel of land with the appurtenances, to him the said John J. Mason his heirs and assigns forever and the said Sledge and wife Covenant with the said Mason that he shall have quiet possession and a good title to the said land and to the claim of all persons whatsoever.
