This Incanture made the twenty sixth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty four between William S. Belbo and Sarah S. his wife, of the County of Surry and State of Virginia, of the one part and Henry Stacey and James Peters of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, of the other part. That the said William S. Belbo and Sarah S. his wife in consideration of the sum of three hundred and sixty two dollars and no parts of a cent lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Henry Stacey and James Peters at or before the making and delivery of this presents the receipt whereof is hereby attested unto the said Henry Stacey and James Peters their heirs and assigns all their right title and interest in a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and being formerly the property of George Meade and purchased by him of Sampson Little and by the lands of William Belbo on the west by the stream of Jacks Swamp and on the West by lands unknown. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the tenements hereto annexed and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold, rendered every part and parcel thereof with every of their heirs and assigns forever and the said William S. Belbo and Sarah S. his wife for having sold, their heirs and assigns, their rights, title and interest in the said tract or parcel of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Henry Stacey and James Peters their heirs and assigns for ever from the claim or claims of them the said William S. Belbo and Sarah S. his wife, or either of them, their heirs or either of their heirs, and all and every person or persons whatsoever shall well and as warrant and forever defend by these presents.
