This Indenture made this 26th day of November in the year of Our Lord Christ 1834 between
Samuel JONES and his wife Peggy of the one part and Richard H. Brunch of the other, all of the
County of Southampton and parish of Holloway Hemifield that the said Samuel Jones and
Peggy his wife in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and fifty dollars of judgment
of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Richard H. Brunch as and for the
returning and delivery of three presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained
and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said
Richard H. Brunch his heirs and assigns three certain Tracts or parcels of land lying and
being in the County aforesaid one containing severally seven acres more or less called Hatchet
land one other tract of thirty three acres being the land that James Cunnell stand-
ed for and one other tract of ninety eight acres it being the tract formerly owned
by Lawrence Jones and all those tracts adjoining each other making in the whole ten acres
and eight acres more or less and bounded on the North by Bradshaws Hill from the
first by Thomas Dury's land and the land called Masons on the South by Sieckahill
Shores land and the land called Bulls, and on the East by the land of Britton
Brashaw - reference to former deeds being had will more fully appear together
with all the houses out houses, edifices, buildings, yards, gardens, orchards, tenan-
tments, with the profits and emoluments with all the appurtenances unto the
to the said 268 acres of land belonging or in any wise appertaining to the same
or any part or parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said Tracts of land as also
cited with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging whatsoever
Richard H. Brunch his heirs and assigns forever and the said Samuel Jones and his
Peggy for themselves and their heirs the said land with all and singular the houses
and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Richard H. Brunch his heirs
and assigns, free from the claim or claims of them or either of them their worthies
first, and of all controversy person, or persons whatsoever I shall will and desire and
and forever defend by these presents. In witness whereof the said Samuel Jones
