do give and grant unto the said W^m Prince and his executors administrators and assigns my War-
rent tract of land containing 813 acres bounded by the lands of James C. Peters on the East by
the town of Calverton these ad on the South side and on the West side by the said Elizabeth Porter
from thence to the bottom Swamp. To have and to hold the said Land unto the said W^m Prince
his executors administrators and assigns forever And the said Elizabeth Porter
for herself her executors administrators and assigns against the claim of her the said Eliza-
beth Porter her executors administrators and assigns the claims of claims of all and every
person or persons whatsoever Shall and lawfully warrant and forever defend them by these
