H Golden Frances his Wife and Disey Bond, for and in consideration of the sum of
one hundred and twenty five dollars, to them in hand paid or secured to be paid, and before
the executing and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have bargained, sold, sold, and conveyed these presents, do hereby bargain and sell unto
the said Ruffin Hart One certain tract or parcel of land, lying and being in the County
of Southampton and bounded by the lands of said Ruffin Hart andatham persons
the main run of Dracott hundred the lightwood Swamp, it being all the land where
William Golden late of Southampton County, died seized and possessed of containing
by estimation sixty Acres be the same more or less together with all and singular the
premises and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining.
To have and to hold the said land with its tenements hereditaments and all and singular
other the premises and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Ruffin Hart his
heirs and assigns forever, free from the claim or claims of them the said William
Henry Golden, Frances his Wife and Disey Bond their heirs and assigns, and from the
lawful claims or claims of all and every other person or persons whomsoever, claiming
by, from or through them or either of them well warrant and forever defend by these
presents. In Witness whereof the said William H Golden Frances his Wife and
