 horse, one cow and a yearling, one sow and a pig, one hog twenty five barrels of Corn, ten
 thousand pounds of fodder, eight thousand eight of pork, two slaves and other
 mining utensils, household and kitchen furniture &c to the only proper use and the
 half of him the said James Deneo his heirs Ex^{ors} adm^{ors} and assigns forever and the
 said John Darden for himself his heirs executors and administrators, with lawful
 covenants, promises and agree to and with the said James Deneo &c in manner and
 form following that is to say that the said John Darden his heirs executors and
 the afore said property hereby conveyed unto the said James Deneo &c against the
 persons whomsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents
 trust notwithstanding that the said James Deneo shall permit the said John Darden
 to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the said personal property hereby conveyed
 and take the profits thereof to his own use until default be made in the payment
 of the said bond either in the whole or in part, and then upon this further trust
 that they, he or any two of them shall and will do soon after the happening of the
 default of payment any third party, or the said John Darden his heirs or
