to Fitzhugh of the one part and Jacob B. Bryant of the other part both of the County of
Bryantampton Virginia that the said Thomas Fitzhugh for and in consideration of to him
Eight hundred dollars good and lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the
said Jacob B. Bryant the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given, granted, conveyed
and sold unto and to the heirs of the said Jacob B. Bryant his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land
being in the County of said and containing four hundred and twenty acres more or
less being the portion allotted to the said Thomas Fitzhugh under a deed of the County of
Southampton lying on both sides of the Rottaway River and bounded as follows to wit by the
lands of Isaac Wendall, Buckhorn Swamp, and by the courses of Bailey Bryant, purchaser of the
said Peter on the south side of Rottaway River the part on the north side of the River is bounded
by the lands of Mr. Rebecca Simmons and Jesse Little which he purchased of Mr. Simmons
and the lands of Bailey Bryant which he purchased of Mr. J. Peter and the lands of
John Fitzhugh to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and premises unto
of its heirs and assigns unto him the said Jacob B. Bryant his heirs and assigns forever
And the said Thomas Fitzhugh his heirs, executors & administrators well warrant and
defence the aforesaid tract of land premises unto him the said Jacob B. Bryant his
