This Indenture made and entered into on the 19th day of January one thousand eight hundred
 and thirty five Between James Channel of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the
 first part and James D. Bryant of the County afores^d and State of the second part and Everett Bryant
 of this same County and State of the third part in Order to secure the payment of a certain debt
 by said having even date with this Indenture which said debt is due unto the said Everett Bryant
 for the sum of Thirty eight dollars and Eleven cents in consideration of the sum of the dollar jointly
 the said James D. Bryant to wit at and before the encoding and delivery of this Indenture
 is hereby acknowledged that the said James Channel hath granted bargained and sold with the
 presents with grant bargain and sell unto the said James D. Bryant the following property
 wit One horse two feather beds and furniture then on hand of logs Chests & a spinning wheel
 & sitting Chairs & glass boxes & iron cages one goat box & a few other things my best of service
 for the coming year and one thousand pound said Cotton to be taken out of my evening of
 Cotton to have and to hold the said property above mentioned to be lawfully granted unto the said
 of these appointments unto the said James D. Bryant his heirs, executors or assigns and assigns forever
 Upon Trust nevertheless that the said James D. Bryant shall as soon as conveniently after he
 advised the time and place of sale of the property aforesaid in at least three public places
 residence of said James Channel proceed to sell the same to the highest bidder and out of the
 moneys arising from the sale in the first place to pay and satisfy all reasonable charges att
 ing such sale and then the debt above mentioned and the balance of the moneys arising from
 such sale aforesaid to the use of the said James Channel his Executors or assigns or to such
 person or persons as he by writing from under his hand shall appoint and in default of such ap
 pointment to such person or persons as he shall be entitled by virtue of Statute for Distribution to
 estate here may follow. Covenants and agrees that the said James Channel shall and lawfully
 Decided shall ease on the payments of the debt and costs to secure which the property aforesaid
 for quiet enjoyment free from encumbrances and for further assurance doth hereby deliver up
 have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals this 19th day of January 1835
