

This Indenture made this 10th day of January in the year of our said English monarchs and thirty for li-
son Nelson Holloman the trustee of the first part William Holt of the second part and Richard Roth of the
third part. Whereas the said William Holt on the 15th day of October eight hundred and thirty was in
debtor to secure the payment of the sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars to the said Richard Roth and
his heirs or assigns of that date convey to the said William Holloman his heirs executors &c the following
containing One hundred and twenty acres more or less bounded as follows Viz on the North and East by the
lands of Emma Bailey's heirs on the South by the lands of Joseph Harts heirs on the North by the lands
of Henry Holloman also on the West by the lands of Joseph Harts heirs on the North by the lands
mentioned in the said deed of trust was on the 15th day of October 1832 with all its benefits
and does refer to a certain John Holt of the County of Henry and State of Virginia by the said
Richard Roth by an endorsement on said deed and Whereas since the execution and delivery of the said
deed of trust and since the said assignments the said William Holt has fully satisfied and paid to the said
John Holt the several sums of money thereby secured which the said John Holt at the duty acknowledging
of One dollar in hand paid by the said William Holt to the said Nelson Holloman at and before the ex-
ecution and delivery of the said deed of trust and the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Nelson Holloman
and the said John Holt having granted bargained and sold conveyed released and confirmed and by
these presents do grant bargain and sell remise release and confirm unto the said William Holt all the
estate right title interest claim and demand both at law and in equity which the said William Holt
man and John Holt have or shall in the land or lands above described. To have and to hold the said
tract or parcel of land together with the appurtenances to the said William Holt his heirs
his heirs executors and assigns forever to the only purposes and behoof of him the said William Holt
his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever and the said Nelson Holloman and John Holt for them
selves their heirs executors and administrators the above mentioned land and slave unto the said William
Holt his heirs executors and administrators and assigns in as full and ample manner as the same was con-
veyed by the said William Holt by the deed of trust above recited as was and the same to the said William
Holt against the claim or claims of them the said Nelson Holloman or John Holt and all persons claim-
ing by or under them or either of them. In Witness whereof the parties to these presents have hereunto
set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above written.
