This Indenture made this 10th day of January in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and thirty four between Nelson Holloman the trustee of the first part William Holt of the second part and Richard Borth of the third part. Whereas the said William Holt on the 15th day of October last past hundred and thirty one in year to secure the payment of the sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars to the said Richard Borth and by indenture of trust of that date convey to the said Nelson Holloman his heirs executors &c the following property to wit One certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and containing one hundred and twenty acres more or less bounded as follows Beginning at the North end Bounding by the lands of Conrad Bailey's heirs on the South by the lands of Joseph White heirs on the North by the lands of Mary Holloman alias one Negro man named Mike esq'r trust for her use and purpose in the said indenture mentioned which said tract of land was on the thirteenth day of April 1833 sold at its bidding Richard Borth by an endorsement on said deed and whereas since the granting and delivery of the said tract of trust and since the said assignment the said William Holt has fully satisfied and paid to the said John Holt the several sums of money thereby secured which he said John Holt doth hereby acknowledge & pay. This Indenture witnesseth that for the considerations aforesaid as well as for the further consideration of One dollar in hand paid by the said William Holt to the said Nelson Holloman at and before the execution and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Nelson Holloman with the receipt and acknowledgment of the said John Holt signed by both being party to these presents and the said John Holt having granted his quiet and sole possession released and confirmed by these presents against his gain and sell no manner of claim and demand both at law and equity which he said Nelson Holloman and John Holt have or had in the land or slave above described to him and to his heirs the said tract or parcel of land together with the aforesaid slave to the said William Holt his heirs &c administrators and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said William Holt his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever unto the said Nelson Holloman and John Holt for themselves their heirs executors and administrators the aforesaid land and slaves unto the said William Holt his heirs executors and administrators and assigns in as full and ample manner as the same was executed by the said William Holt by the due of trust aforesaid as well as the sum to the said William Holt against the claims or demands of them the said Nelson Holloman or John Holt and all persons claiming by or under them either of them.
