 Aris, Clary, Aris & Aris, Aris of the County of South Hampton and State of Virginia of the one
 part, and Elizabeth Atkinson of the County and State of the other part: Witnesseth that the
 said Aris for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty dollars to them in hand paid by the
 said Elizabeth Atkinson before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they
 do hereby acknowledge they the said Arises have granted bargained and sold by these presents
 as against bargain and sell to Elizabeth Atkinson One certain tract or parcel of land lying and
 in the County aforesaid containing by estimation fourteen acres to the sum more or less and being
 as follows Beginning in Ross Swamp at the mouth of Furrough branch and thence
 said branch to the fork & thence up the north fork of the said branch to the corner of
 Bottles estate and thence along down the S. Bottles line to the said Ross Swamp and thence
 along down the said Swamp to the beginning; And all the said rights titles claims & demands
 whatsoever of them the said Arises of in & to the same or any part thereof To have and to
 the said tract or parcel of land & premises unto the said Elizabeth Atkinson her heirs and assigns
 forever In Witness whereof we the said Arises have hereunto set our hands and seals the

 Virginia of the one part and Benjamin Crumpler of the County of South Hampton and State of Virginia
 the other part Witnesseth that the said Peter Russell doth for and in consideration of the sum of
 Forty dollars have paid money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Benjamin Crumpler
 in the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge he
 have granted bargained and sold release ratify and confirm unto the said Benjamin Crumpler his heirs and assigns
 forever all my joint and several rights in and to a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being
 in the County of South Hampton and State of the aforesaid containing by estimation thirteen
 the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Commencing at Blackwater run at a
 then at the swampy run of Blackwater to the Gum hole corner at a top of the said swampy
 marked trees west course to Navy Island Branch to Black corner tree down said branch
 Gum corner tree all the land in these Bounds to have and to hold the said right in and to the
 said land together with all and singular the appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the
 said Benjamin Crumpler his heirs and assigns forever
 And the said Peter Russell doth hereby further Covenant promise and agree with the said Benjamin Crumpler
 and his heirs forever that the said land and every part thereof is clear and free from all
 grants sales leases mortgages and all other manner of
 claims whatsoever except the aforesaid Benjamin Crumpler and his heirs and assigns
