of them with bargain and sell to the said Thomas B. Williamson on his heirs and assigns a certain
tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing three hundred
and seventy acres be the same more or less and being the land which I inherited from my father
and bounded as follows to wit by the lands of Joseph Hurrell deceased Joseph William
Hurrell and William Wright deceased to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land the
tenements hereunto and all and singular other the premises therein before mentioned or con-
taind to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and
appurtenances to the said Thomas B. Williamson his heirs and assigns forever and the said
Roger Lundy and his wife Rebecca Thas for themselves and their heirs the said land with the here-
unto the premises and appurtenances before mentioned to the said Thomas B. Williamson his heirs
