This Indenture made this 15th day of September one thousand eight hundred and thirty four between
John D. Maget of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part & Martha Maget
widow of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part (Witnesseth) that the said
John D. Maget & Martha Maget his wife for and in consideration for the sum of ten hundred and twenty five
dollars to them in hand paid by the said Henry B. Bishop the net of which sum is hereby acknowledged
to have been granted bargained and sold and by these presents to give, grant bargain and sell unto the
said John D. Maget his heirs & assigns forever a certain lot or parcel of land containing sixty six
acres and one hundred by lot 1st division by Joseph Drury of the land belonging to the said
John D. Maget which said hundred well more fully appears by reference to the division of the land
lying to the said John D. Maget & c. also an eighth part interest and claim in and to the land
which was assigned to my Mother Bridget Maget. To Have and to hold the said sixty six acres
and one hundred interest with its appurtenances unto him the said Henry B. Bishop and his heirs for
ever and the said John D. Maget & Martha Maget his wife their heirs & assigns the said 1st part of said
land and their interest in the its appurtenances to him the said Henry B. Bishop his heirs and as-
signs shall and well warrant and forever defend. In Witness whereof the said John D. Maget & Martha
