 of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and sold and by these pre-
 sents do bargain and sell unto the said Carr Drovers his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of
 land situate lying and being in the County aforesaid and containing by estimation One hundred
 and twenty six Acres to the same more or less. It being a part of the Wells Johnson tract and bounded
 as follows: Viz Beginning at Cypress a Corner tree of the lands of William Beale do or Beale's
 river thence along a line of maple trees to Seth's Cobb's line thence said Cobb's line to a double
 branch thence up said branch to a maple on Brother's Bergant's line thence along along said
 line to the run of the trough branch thence down the run of the run of the trough branch to the
 river thence down the said river to the first station together with all and singular the premises and
 vines remainder and remainders hereby and other rents issues and profits thereof and every part and
 parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract of land with the tenements hereto thereto
