lying on the fork of the Petersburg and Smithfield roads being part of the purchased manor of the ex-
ecutors of Robert Ricks containing seven hundred and forty six acres more or less to have and to hold
the said tract or parcel of land unto him the said Thomas Jefferson Trotter his heirs and assigns
forever and the said Thomas Trotter and Jane for themselves their heirs executors and administrators
the said tract or parcel of land unto the said Thomas Jefferson Trotter his heirs and assigns
and assigns against the claims of them the said Thomas Trotter & Jane his wife their executors and
administrators and against the claims or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever claim-
ing by or through them and their heirs and assigns and defend by their presents. Witness our hands and
