This Indenture made and executed this 22nd day of April 1834 A.D. One thousand eight hundred and thirty four between Tarlton W. Scott and Ellen Scott his wife of the first part and John C. Scott of the second part all of the County of Pamlico and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Tarlton W. Scott and Ellen Scott his wife have for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and sixty dollars to them in hand paid by the said John C. Scott the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged bargain and sold and do by these presents bargain and sell unto and confirm unto the said John C. Scott his heirs executors and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying in this County containing by Survey One hundred and forty four acres more or less bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a small black Gum Corner between Bailey and Porters Branch in this tract thence S 75° E 15 poles along a line of marked trees called Gum in the run of a small Branch thence down the run of said branch along a line of marked trees the various courses thereof 156 poles to a black Gum in the conjunction of the said main and a small branch thence down the run thereof along a line of marked trees the various courses thereof 50 poles to a pine thence along a line of marked trees S 26° E 38 poles to a oak corner between this tract and Tarlton W. Scott in Daniel Beales dec'd line thence along the same line S 47° W 10 poles to a black Gum thence S 56° W 16 poles to a pine thence S 53° W 23 poles to a pine thence S 16° W 16 poles to a post Oak a Corner of the said Daniel Beales dec'd line and George Selig's thence S 47° W 16 poles to a pine thence S 20° W 7 poles to a pine thence S 64° W 14 poles to a line of marked trees to a pine Corner of this tract and Daniel Beales dec'd tract thence S 47° E 20 poles to a black Oak at 44° W 15 poles to a pine Corner of Daniel Beales and Bailey Bryant thence S 8° E 15 poles to a black Oak at 41° W 16 poles to an Oak thence N 8° E 24 poles to a small hickory thence S 17° E 15 poles to a black Oak at 13 1/2° E 6 poles to the Beginning To have and to hold the aforesaid premises with appurtenances and parcel thereof unto and to the said John C. Scott his heirs executors and assigns forever and yearly and their heirs forever. And the said Tarlton W. Scott and Ellen Scott his wife do sell their said tract and a part thereof unto and to the said John C. Scott his heirs executors and assigns forever and their heirs forever. And the said Tarlton W. Scott and Ellen Scott do give and warrant unto the said John C.
