acknowledged the same after it was fully explained to her and freely and apart from her husband to be  
her own act and that she had willingly signed and sealed the same an witnesseth contract it given  
under our hands and seals this 26<sup>th</sup> day of February 1835

This Indenture made and entered into on this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred  
and forty five Between Benjamin E. Poje of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and  
John Bartham of the same County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Benjamin E. Poje  
for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred dollars current money of this Commonwealth to him  
in hand paid, or secured to be paid, by the said John Bartham at or before the sealing and delivery of these  
present the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, mortgaged and con-  
ferred, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell all and confirm unto him the said John  
Bartham his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the  
aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke Containing by a late Survey Four hundred  
and forty three Acres (as the same now or less) and bounded by the lines of James Taylor, George Williams  
the Councillor, and others being the tract or parcel of land that Joseph Poje purchased of Doctor Carter  
Carmine, and bequeathed to the said Benjamin E. Poje in his last Will and Testament. To have and to  
hold the above described tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances thereunto belonging  
from and after the 25<sup>th</sup> day of December next (at which time the said Benjamin E. Poje goes to Virginia)  
unto him the said John Bartham his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only purpose and intent of  
him the said John Bartham his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Benjamin E. Poje for himself  
his heirs executors and administrators doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said John Bartham his heirs  
executors and assigns that he will by these presents from and after the 25<sup>th</sup> day of December next  
relinquish and forever desist the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land  
and premises and every part or parcel thereof against the claims or demands of all and every person or  
persons whatsoever. In Witness whereof the said Benjamin E. Poje hath hereunto set his  
hand and affixed his seal the day and year first above written -
