of the County of Southampton of the first part and Thomas C Jones of the said County of the
said part Wiltshirepeth that the said Margaret Summers for and in Consideration of the sum
of one hundred dollars lawful money of this Commonwealth to her in hand paid or becoming due to her
by the said Thomas C Jones at or before the recording and delivery of these presents doth hereby
acknowledgede hath granted bargained sold aliened released and Conveyed unto the
said persons doth grant bargain sell alien release and convey unto the said Thomas C Jones a certain
tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton near the town of Stowmarket
beginning at a post on the road about five hundred and a twenty eight years from the old Cattell
Streets lot now occupied and owned by D. L. C. Sergeant hence back a straight line about
one hundred and five yards to a post thence a straight line about north west to Redditch
on the path leading from the main Road to the old Race field thence by the said path and
the main Road to the beginning saving and reserving the same year manufacture especially
the same land sold by Robert Gordon to Sir and Lady and as for all of more in the Clerk Office
of Southampton To have and to hold the said grantee premises or parcel of land with
the buildings rights fixtures emoluments and appurtenances to him the said Thomas C Jones
his heirs and assigns forever against the Clains & Claimes of her the said Margaret Summers
all and every person or persons whatever and the same as above Conveyed she doth hereby give
warrant and defend for herself her heirs executors and administrators holding the same forever by these presents

of the sum of One thousand dollars to them in hand paid or secured to be paid to him
James H Selwell and Nicholas M Selwell at or before the recording and delivery of these
presents doth grant bargain sell alien release and convey unto the said
Conveyee and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release and convey unto the said
James H and Nicholas M Selwell a certain lot or piece of land situate in and adjoining to
the Town of Jerusalem in the County of Southampton and containing by a circuit square
and two hundred acres to the same number less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a corner
the piazza of the house now occupied by the said Thomas C Jones as a lower corner of the said
lot land hence 115' N 22. 2' poles up the main street to a corner on S. C. Sergeant's
C. S. 8' poles to a corner on Lewis C Sergeant's and Thomas C Jones' houses 155' E 14' poles
to a scaffold 8' to a corner on Thomas C Jones and the house of Henry Gately hence 153' N 22'
poles to a rightward 8' to a corner on the side house houses 24' 8' 28' poles to a party wall
