This Indenture made and entered into this 26th day of March in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and thirty five, between Richard Mornell and his wife Peter ^{Wife} Mornell and Martha ^{Married} Mornell his wife and Mary Mornell of the County of Southampton and State of Virg^e of the one part and William Mornell of the same County and State of the other part Whereas that the said Richard Mornell & his wife Peter Mornell and Martha his wife and Mary Mornell for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and twenty five dollars current money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by this said William Mornell ^{on} the 21st day before the recording and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargains and sold and by these presents have and each of them doth grant, bargain and sell also, except & Confirm unto him the said William Mornell his heirs and assigns forever all the right title interest claims or demands of him and to a certain undivided tract or parcel of land of which James Mornell now holds in possession that came to him by the death of his brother John Mornell living and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton & Saint Lukes parish Contayng by estimation One hundred and forty four Acres be the same more or less as bounded by the head of James Mornell Street Barnes and others together with all and singular the appurtenances belonging or in any wise appertaining to their said Interest or proportionable parts of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises to have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises of them the said Richard Mornell and his wife Peter Mornell with his wife and Mary Mornell of him and to the aforesaid undivided tract or parcel of land
