This Indenture made and entered into this 26th day of March in the year of our said Eighteen hundred and thirty five, between Richard Horrell and Leiza his Wife Peter Horrell and Martha Horrell his wife and Mary Horrell of the County of Southampton and State of Virg^a of the one part and William Horrell of the same County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Richard Horrell & Leiza his Wife Peter Horrell and Martha his Wife and Mary Horrell for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and twenty four dollars current money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said William Horrell at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained and sold and by these presents they and each of them doth grant bargain sell assign, convey & confirm unto him the said William Horrell his heirs and assigns forever all the right title interest claims or demands of in and to a certain undivided tract or parcel of land of which James M. Horrell now holds in possession that came to them by the death of their father John Horrell lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton & said Leiza provided that by estimation One hundred and forty four Acres be the same more or less and bounded by the land of James M. Horrell Jacob Barnes and others together with all and singular the appurtenances belonging or in any wise appertaining to their said interest or proportional parts of the aforesaid tracts or parcel of land and premises. To have and to hold the aforesaid undivided tract and premises of them the said Richard Horrell and Leiza his wife Peter Horrell and Mary Horrell of in and to the aforesaid undivided tract or parcel of land
