 for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Cordy Pope his heirs & assigns
 forever, and the said Peter McCorrell and Martha his wife for themselves their heirs
 executors & administrators do and each of them doth hereby Covenant and agree to and under
 the said Cordy Pope his heirs, executors, admors, and assigns that they will by their power
 warrant and force defend the right and title to said land hereby conveyed against the
