

The Claims This Indenture made this first day of April 1835 Between Matthew Williams of
 to the first part James Vick of the second part and John Vick Creator of the 3^d part all of the
 County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said Matthew
 Williams for an inconsideration of the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said
 James Vick at or before the sealing of ~~this~~ ^{the} indenture the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 as well as the further consideration of the said Matthew Williams being justly
 indebted to the said John Vick in the just and full sum of Six hundred and ninety four
 dollars due by him having date the first of April 1835 I also secure to the said
 Vick so much of my property as will secure him as my security at this time to the said
 Vick may not suffer by me in any way and the said debt to be paid of us good money
 without shew (Witness) that the said Matthew Williams is willing to secure the said
 Vick which is the sole object of their presence hath granted bargain and sold unto
 the said James Vick his heirs or assigns all my lands known by the following names
 One small tract called the Slade tract, One by the name of Key tract, One by the name of
 Williams tract near the Supper line and the home tract and also (unclear) also two small
 tracts for ever to Thomas Melton by the names of Dudley & Son the residue after the said
 Thomas Melton is paid up to this date, I convey to the said James Vick his heirs or assigns
 upon being requested by the said John Vick his heirs or assigns shall make sale of the same
 mentioned at public sale for the best price that can be obtained for the same any time after
 the 2^d of April 1835 after advertising ten days previous to the day of sale at the Court
 house door or in as many other places as the said James Vick may think fit and with
 the money arising from the said sales first pay unto the said John Vick all his just
 claims as his Crede and as my and all Cost which may accrue in making sales of the
 same property and then pay unto the said Matthew Williams his heirs or assigns
 the overplus if any and the said Matthew Williams for himself his heirs or assigns
 with warrant the receipt to the aforesaid property unto the said James Vick his heirs or assigns
 for the purpose aforesaid doth warrant and defend the right against any lawful claim
 of the said Matthew Williams or any other Claimer whatsoever Claiming or demanding the
 same or any part thereof and the said James Vick for himself his heirs or assigns agrees
 to make sales of the above mentioned property when requested by the said John Vick
 or his heirs or assigns In testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and
